The Organismo Italiano di Contabilità (OIC) is organizing an event on March 27, 2026 to debate the future of standard-setting

The need for a common accounting language, through standardisation, is widely recognised. The globalization of financial markets requires a uniform language to ensure the comparability of investments.

However, accounting and sustainability standard-setting has to balance the need for global harmonization on the one hand, and the need not to compromise the international competitiveness of companies and not to ignore national specificities on the other.

The differing international political approaches to ESG issues and the resulting impact on companies, the need for simplification that characterizes reporting, especially sustainability reporting, and the arising of local financial information needs that cannot be met at international level, are some of the aspects that will be addressed during the event promoted by the OIC.

Representatives of several international standard setters, as well as members of listed companies and the financial community will participate.
